# Paul's Trial Before Festus

## I APPEAL UNTO CAESAR

*"For if I be an offender, or have committed any thing worthy of death, I refuse not to die: but if there be none of these things whereof these accuse me, no man may deliver me unto them. I appeal unto Caesar. Then Festus, when he had conferred with the council, answered, Hast thou appealed unto Caesar? Unto Caesar shalt thou go". (Acts 25: 11-12)*

*"And on the morrow, when Agrippa was come, and Bernice, with great pomp, and was entered into the place of hearing..."*

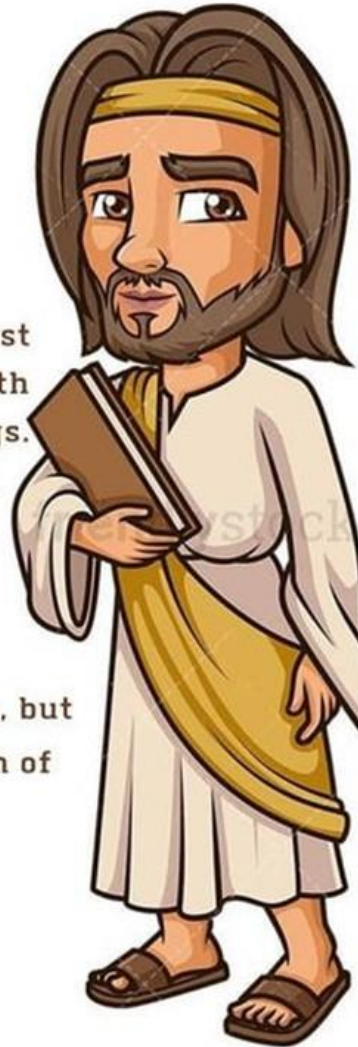

# SIMON

Salvation in Christ

- Simon the Zealot, one of Jesus Christ's 12 apostles.
- Simon left everything in his previous life to follow Jesus. He lived true to the Great Commission after Jesus' ascension.
- This means Simon was one of the people who was closest to Jesus, and that he spent about three years living with him, witnessing his miracles, and hearing his teachings. He saw numerous demonstrations of Jesus' divinity.
- Simon was a great debater; he did like to argue.
- He was a rebel by nature and an iconoclast by training, but Jesus won him for the higher concepts of the kingdom of heaven.
- He went everywhere preaching the gospel of Jesus and baptizing believers. He spread the gospel as a missionary and was departed as a faithful disciple.

# CENSUS 101: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

The 2020 Census is closer than you think!  
Here's a quick refresher of what it is and why it's essential that everyone is counted.

## Everyone counts.

The census counts every person living in the United States once, only once, and in the right place.



## It's in the Constitution.

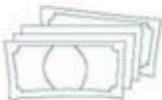
The U.S. Constitution mandates that everyone in the country be counted every 10 years. The first census was in 1790.

## It's about fair representation.

Every 10 years, the results of the census are used to reapportion the House of Representatives, determining how many seats each state gets.



## It's about \$675 billion.



The distribution of more than \$675 billion in federal funds, grants, and support to states, counties, and communities are based on census data.

That money is spent on schools, hospitals, roads, public works, and other vital programs.



## It's about redistricting.

After each decade's census, state officials redraw the boundaries of the congressional and state legislative districts in their states to account for population shifts.

## Taking part is your civic duty.

Completing the census is mandatory: it's a way to participate in our democracy and say "I COUNT!"



# THE CENSUS



- Every 5 years every Roman man had to register for the Census
  - The men had to declare their family, wife, children, slaves, and riches
  - If a man didn't do this his possessions would be confiscated
- 
- If a man wanted to free his slave he would only have to enter his name as a citizen at the census

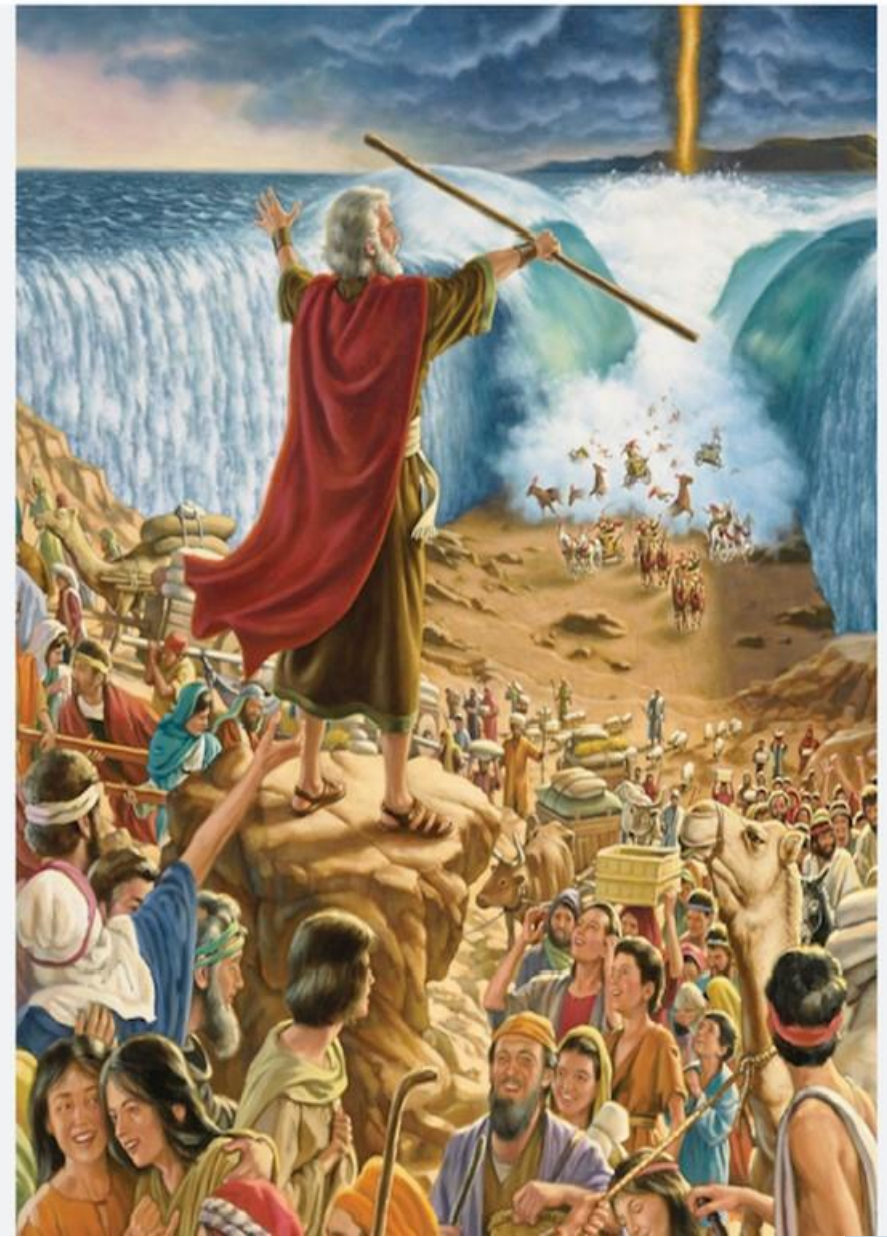

# \*1<sup>st</sup> Revolt against Rome\*

- By the first century AD, many Jews in Jerusalem had grown tired of foreign rule.
- These Jews thought if they could regain their independence they could re-create the kingdom of Israel.
- These Jews that rebelled against the Romans were called Zealots.

## Zealots:

- Believed Jews should only answer to God
- Refused to obey Roman officials
- Urged other Jews to rise up against the Romans
- AD66: Led by the Zealots, the Jews revolted. (Lasted 4 years)
- Results of 1<sup>st</sup> Revolt:
  - **Jews were unsuccessful**
  - **Jerusalem was ruined**
  - **The Second Temple was burned in AD 70.**
