- 6. * We are glad to see youth who have grown more mature and helped with the Egg Hunt, games, and Easter Story. Thank the parents for helping as well.
- 7. * We had enough materials at craft station, and one necklace style was very popular.
- 8. * It was great to have Egg Hunt 2nd time for some families that arrived late.

- 9* All 200 small fish were scooped up; Garden Smart was fun; Cotton Candy station was super busy.

 10* Photoshop, bounce house, and soft play went smoothly.
- 11* Surprisingly, Indian kids also memorized Bible Verses at the Bible Memory Verse station. Ex, Genesis 1:1, John 3:16
- 12* Thank Shi Jing sister for helping (L) bounce house at the last minute and Limin, Phoebe helping with the fish area the last minute. Thank Bill and Eunice for helping the Cotton Candy and John Chen for helping those who didn't have the stamp cards. Thank everyone who stepped in to help, even though they were not on the volunteer list. Thank Allen C and Roger for helping from the beginning to the end. It was amazing.

- 5. *For the Cotton Candy, we will limit to no more than two per a person because one of the kids had 20. Cantonese coworkers were overwhelmed.
- 6. * We ran out of 138 stamp cards, so some people did not get the stamp cards. Then 60 copies were made, and 20 were used.
- 7. * People showed up early to register. If the flyer says starting at 11:30am, then the registration table has to start at 10:45 am.
- 8. * People asked if Baptism could start one week before Easter Sunday. Baptism does not have to be on Easter Sunday. It's also good to be baptized on Palm Sunday.
